



Journey of Hope Program Bilingual Clinician (Spanish/English)

Reports to: Lead Clinician

Hours: Full-time, exempt position with flexibility for participation in an On-Call rotation.

General Statement of Duties: The Clinician shall conduct mental health assessments for all children in care, as well as provide ongoing support in an individual and group setting. Practices crisis intervention and must be available for on-call rotation and psychiatric emergencies. In conjunction with referring agency, Clinician establishes goals regarding preparation for family reunification and behavior management. Clinician coordinates and schedules the development of the Individual Service Plans and utilizes team approach to the care of children to ensure coordination of services. Actively collaborates with residential staff and school staff to collect information regarding resident's participation in program. The ratio of UC to clinicians shall not be greater than 12:1. ORR (Office of Refugee and Resettlement) will have final approval of any candidate that is hired for this position.

Please Note: Candidates will be required to show proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 upon commencing employment. Reasonable accommodations will be considered on a case-by-case basis for exemptions to this requirement in accordance with applicable law. Applicants should be aware that for client-facing roles, particularly those involving close contact with vulnerable individuals, accommodations that involve remaining unvaccinated against COVID-19 may not be deemed reasonable. The Company will engage in the interactive process on an individualized basis in light of each particular role.

Minimum Requirements:

Clinicians shall have a bachelor's degree in in psychology, sociology or other relevant behavior science in which clinical experience is a program requirement and must also have 5 years clinical employment experience, OR a master's degree in social work

(MSW) or Master's degree in psychology, sociology or other relevant behavior science in which clinical experience is a program requirement.

It is preferred that candidates with master's also have 2 years of postgraduate direct service delivery experience. All candidates must be Licensed or eligible for licensure. Must have Act 33, 34 and FBI Clearances. Candidate must be fluent in both English and Spanish (read, write and speak). EOE
