Hours: Part-time/Occasional with flexible schedule to meet the needs of the clients.

General Statement of Duties:

The Occasional Outpatient Therapist provides individual, family, and group therapy to children within the schools during the school day, generally between the hours of 8 am and 3 pm. Some evening hours maybe needed to provide a time to meet for family therapy on occasion. Candidates could apply for one or multiple school locations. LSW, LCSW, or LPC is required for this position.

Please Note: Candidates will be required to show proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 upon commencing employment. 5. Presents a thorough clinical impression of a client's mental state and the efficiency of interventions at Clinical Consult Meetings.
6. Completes all required documentation to agency standards in a timely manner.
7. Develops Discharge Planning.
8. Maintains client confidentiality.
9. Attends all mandatory training.
10. Is willing to provide therapeutic services at any of our office locations.

Minimum Qualifications:

Candidate must possess a Master's degree in Social Work and or possess a Master's degree in counseling and must have LSW, LCSW or LPC. A minimum of (2) Years clinical experience with children, adults and families is preferred. The candidate must have ACT 33/34 & FBI clearances and a valid PA driver's license. **EOE**
